Non Pony Club members are welcome in all classes. Only Pony Club Members can qualify for the Finals in October at Bishop Burton.

Ring 1 Classes start at 9.00am.

(All entries via horsevents.co.uk. No entries on the day. Entries close Thursday, 28th April 2022)

- Class 1 30cm - Genuine Lead Rein
- Class 2 40cm - Just off Lead Rein
- Class 3a 50cm - 10 years and under on 1 January 2022
- Class 3b 50cm - Over 10 years
- Class 4* 60-65cm Open to all ages.
(To include Pony Club Area 3 Junior Series Showjumping Qualifier - teams and individuals - PC members must be 10 years and under on 1 January 2022.)
- Class 5* 70-75cm Open to all ages.
(To include Pony Club Area 3 Junior Series Showjumping Qualifier - teams and individuals - PC members must be 12 years and under on 1 January 2022.)
- Class 6* 80-85cm Open to all ages.
(To include Pony Club Area 3 Junior Series Showjumping Qualifier - teams and individuals - PC members must be 12 years and under on 1 January 2022.)
- Class 7 90-95cm Open to all ages.

Classes 1 - 3b £12 per round and Classes 4 - 7 £14 per round.

Ring 2 Clear Round/Warm Up

(£5 per round. Entry on day - cash only)

9.00am **Clear Round** Select your height - 30cm up to 50cm in preparation for Classes 1 - 3

Warm Up Rounds

55cm ½ hour before the start of Class 4 in Ring 1

65cm ½ hour before the start of Class 5 in Ring 1

75cm ½ hour before the start of Class 6 in Ring 1

85cm ½ hour before the start of Class 7 in Ring 1

Rules for Junior Series Show Jumping Competition 2022

1 Tack

In all classes tack is the same as Rules for Pony Club Show Jumping 2020

2 Course

No upper time limit imposed on any of the classes, therefore no time faults can be incurred.

The competition will be run as Single phase with a minimum of 7 jumps followed by a timed section of no less than four jumps.

The classes are:

60cms with 10 years and under maximum height of jumps 60cms, maximum width of 50cms, maximum of 2 jumps at 65cms in timed section.

70cms 12 years and under maximum height of jumps 70cms, maximum width 60cms, maximum of 2 jumps at 75cms in timed section.

80cms 12 years and under maximum height of jumps 80cms, maximum width of 70cms, maximum of 2 jumps at 85cm in timed section.

The Finals in October 2022 will be run at the same heights as the qualifying rounds.

3 Eligibility

Eligibility will be the same as for the Regional competitions with the exception that the combination must **NOT** have recorded a double clear with British Show Jumping at the following heights or above:

Class 60cm with 10 years and under- 60cm

Class 70cm 12 years and under-80cms

Class 80cm 12 years and under-90cms

No combined teams

4 Numbers to qualify

Top 2 teams at each competition that are not already qualified

The top 3 individuals at each competition that are not already qualified

Qualification will pass down the line to the next eligible team or individual provided that the individual has not accumulated more than 12 faults.

5 Jury Of Appeal

The jury of appeal will consist of the organiser or DC of the host branch and one of the judges.

The Competition

This is a team competition with individuals also being placed.

Allocate your team a name on entry for identification

Individuals can enter the classes

A combination of rider and pony can only jump once in any class on the day.

A rider can jump up to 2 ponies in the same team.
